



## **2021 Scouts BSA National Jamboree** **Mecklenburg County Council Quick Facts**

- **Dates** – July 19-30, 2021 (includes two bonus days prior to Jamboree for Day of Service Project)
- **Location** – Summit Bechtel Reserve in Glen Jean, WV. The 10,000-acre Summit is nestled in the central Appalachian Mountains adjacent to the scenic New River Gorge
- Mecklenburg County Council attendance
  - 3 male BSA troops (36 Scouts and 4 adult leaders per troop)
  - ½ Female BSA troop (18 Scouts and 2 adult leaders)
  - ¼ Venturing crew (can be coed – 8 Venturers and 2 adult leaders)

- **Participation Fee** – Youth = \$1,695 / Adult leaders = \$950 Includes the following:
  - 10 days of attendance at 2021 Scouts BSA National Jamboree including all meals
  - 2 bonus days before the Jamboree to complete Day of Service project
  - 100+ liter Osprey Official Jamboree duffle bag
  - Osprey Official Jamboree daypack
  - Two Official 2021 Jamboree uniform patches, two Council shoulder patches, two troop numerals, Jamboree nameplate
  - One set of Mecklenburg County Council Jamboree patches (additional available for purchase)
  - Jamboree T-shirt and hat (or other SWAG at unit discretion)
  - Pre-Jamboree shakedown campout (April 2021) inclusive of meals
  - Motor coach transportation to and from Jamboree
- **Gear needed** – Scouts BSA provides all troop gear (tents, cots, cook gear, stoves, etc.). Scouts only need to provide personal gear (i.e. sleeping bag, clothing, mess kit, etc.)
- **Body Mass Index limits** – Special Scouts BSA restrictions apply. See Jamboree website for details
- **Meals** – Breakfast and dinner are prepared in unit campsite. Lunch is eaten away from campsite.
- **Jamboree Service Team (Staff)** - Any registered Scout or Scouter age 16+ may apply for full session or half-session. See above website for details. JST fees are paid directly to Scouts BSA
- **Participant Withdrawal Policy** - Consistent with prior MCC Jamboree policy and Scouts BSA guidelines, any participant who desires to withdraw from a Jamboree unit and receive a fee refund must:
  - Notify Jamboree unit leader and Council Jamboree registrar Jim Sander in writing
  - Return all items provided by the Council (i.e. Jamboree patches, duffle, troop numerals, etc.)
  - Any fee refunds will be made **ONLY** after a replacement participant has **COMPLETED** registration **AND** is current on fees

### **Notes:**

- Although not expected, the participant fee may be adjusted for unforeseen cost increases such as fuel surcharges
- Individual units may choose to collect funds for unit-specific items such as patches, neckerchiefs, etc.
- Youth and adults registering after May 1 will be contacted by the Registrar to establish a payment schedule
