Mecklenburg County Council Contingent, June 21 - July 3, 2016 **Youth Application for Scouts & Venturers**

Philmont Scout Ranch is the ultimate High Adventure Base. Since 1938 over one million campers from around the world have enjoyed trekking through the more than 200 square miles of rugged land set among towering mountains, alpine meadows, and awesome vistas of the Sangre de Christo range of the Rocky Mountains in northeastern New Mexico where elevations range from 6,600 to 12,441 feet. Fascinating backcountry programs and over 350 miles of challenging trails await your 12-day expedition.

Youth must be 14 years old before June 21, 2016, OR have completed the 8th grade and be 13 before June 21, 2016. Limited spaces for youth are available in the Council Contingent, which is divided into three 12-member crews. Selection will be based upon the information on this application and date submitted, experience in the Scout/Venturing program, Troop Scoutmaster or Venturing Crew Advisor evaluation, and personal interview with the Philmont Adult Advisors.

The total **estimated** cost is approximately \$2,000 and **is contingent on finalization of transportation costs**. It includes an \$870 Philmont fee, airline fare, ground transportation, lodging, and meals. It does not include personal uniforms, equipment, and spending money. The dates listed above do not include travel and touring time. Departure from Charlotte is typically a few days earlier to provide for pre-trek touring. Payment of fees will be collected in installments on the schedule determined and published by the Expedition Leader and High Adventure Committee. Your submission of this application does not guarantee you a place in the 2016 Philmont Contingent, and in the event you are not selected your fees paid will be returned. All fees must be paid on time according to the published schedule. Fees paid are transferable but not refundable due to commitments necessary to carry out the trip. If you sign up and are selected and later find out you cannot attend, you will receive a refund if there is an alternate to take your place. In the event there is not an alternate, a partial refund may be made to include fees you have paid to date less any expenses relating to contractual agreements made in your

Philmont Trip Rules and Guidelines

- 1. Each participant must pay all fees on time according to the schedule determined and published by the Expedition Leader and the High Adventure Committee. A typical fee payment schedule includes a deposit of from \$100 to \$250 due upon being selected, with the balance due in two or three installments prior to the trip.
- 2. Each participant agrees to attend and fully participate in the Crew Training and planning meetings.
- 3. Complete Official Scout or Venturing Uniform is required for travel, arrival at, and while at Philmont Camping Headquarters.
- 4. Everyone travels in the same group on the same itinerary, according to the plans of the organizing unit.
- 5. Each participant agrees to follow the trail rules that will be established for the crews.
- 6. Each participant agrees to follow the rules established by BSA, Mecklenburg County Council, and Philmont. This includes requirements for age, weight, physical preparation, and medical certification. It also includes current certification in Adult CPR and Wilderness First Aid for all adult advisors.
